Privacy Policy

Introduction

Katy Youth Soccer Association (KYSA) respects each individual's right to personal privacy. We will collect and use information gathered through the Association's web site or through the registration web site(s) only in the ways disclosed in this statement. This statement applies solely to information collected through KYSA's web site from time to time.

Part I. Information Collection

KYSA collects information through our web site at several points when forms are filled out for our Association.

We collect various types of personally identifiable information which is provided to our parent organizations. KYSA does not actively market to children, and we never knowingly ask children to divulge personal information.

We may collect demographic data in order to apply for grants or sponsorships to help reduce the cost of registration for our Member Clubs.

We verify the accuracy of this information by registration forms.

We collect this information through registration forms, adult registration forms and through KidSafe applications. While this information is collected voluntarily, all of this information is mandatory (as required by STYSA) for your child to play soccer.

Part II. Information Usage

The information collected by KYSA will be used for our Association activities only.

We do share data with the following affiliated third parties:

- South Texas Youth Soccer Association (STYSA)
- U.S. Youth Soccer Association (USYSA)

KYSA does not sell, rent or lease its member lists to third parties. KYSA may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of internal or external association partners about a particular activity that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your personal information, such as e-mail, name, address, telephone number is not transferred to the third party.

KYSA strictly prohibits the access, use and/or disclosure of any Association members' personal information (including but not limited to their name, address telephone number or email address) by any individual or group without first obtaining written permission from both the KYSA Board of Directors and

the individual Association member(s). KYSA will aggressively pursue all legal remedies against any individual(s) or group(s) found in violation of this policy.

KYSA may access and/or disclose your personal information if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on USYS, STYSA or KYSA; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of KYSA; or (c) act under severe circumstances to protect the personal safety of members of KYSA or members of the public.

We may offer links to other external Web sites. Please note: When you click on links to other Web sites, we encourage you to carefully read their privacy policies, as their standards may differ from ours.

Our Web site may offer forums or message boards. Please be advised that information posted in these venues becomes public knowledge.

If our policy on information collection or use changes, KYSA will advise by individual mailings or public posting to the KYSA web site within 30 days of such changes.

Part III. Access to Information

KYSA maintains the accuracy of our information by yearly registration and for KidSafe through STYSA background checks. Any parent or guardian may access their own personal information and contact us about inaccuracies they may find. You may have us delete your information from our database by request after the registration period has expired.
